

PERMISSION FOR TRANSIENT STATUS FORM

Transient status for graduate admission is granted for one term only, but may be extended by reapplication. Transcripts are not required, since the signature of the dean of graduate studies at the college/university you are attending will assist in establishing your eligibility for graduate study at Shawnee State University.

Eligibility for Transient Status:

- You must be pursuing a graduate degree (active status) at another regionally accredited institution.
You must be in good standing (3.0 or above graduate grade point average) in your graduate program.
You intend to complete your graduate program at the institution in which you are currently enrolled.

Certain programs/departments at Shawnee State University may have additional eligibility requirements.

To be granted permission for transient status, please follow these steps.
